Promotional Period	This Promotion commences at 12:00pm AEDT on 10 February 2025 and concludes at 12:10pm AEDT on 10 February 2025.
Eligible Entrants	Participation in the Promotion is limited to persons who are, for the duration of the Promotional Period:
	a. aged 18 years or over;
	b. residents of New South Wales;
	 not excluded (including an exclusion direction, exclusion direction or self-exclusion order) from a casino or premises operated by The Star Entertainment Group Limited or its related entities;
	 d. not the subject of a Withdrawal of License from The Star Sydney, The Star Gold Coast or Treasury Brisbane;
	e. not an Invalid Entrant;
	 f. not a director, officer, manager, employee or contractor of The Star Entertainment Group Limited or any of its related entities (including, the Promoter); and

There will only be one 1st prize; one 2nd prize; and one 3rd prize to be awarded.

Prize Determination

THIS IS A GAME OF SKILL. NO ELEMENT OF CHANCE WILL DETERMINE THE WINNERS OF THE PROMOTION

At each Competition, twelve (12) hot dogs and two (2) full jugs of water will be placed in front of each at the Competition Table.

Each Eligible Entrant will have four (4) minutes to eat twelve (12) hot dogs. Eligible Entrants may drink water to assist during the Competition but may not mix water with the food on the platter. If an Eligible Entrant vomits during the Competition, they will be disqualified.

To be determined a winner, an Eligible Entrant needs to eat the most hot dogs in four (4) minutes and must have swallowed all contents (with no remaining food left to be eaten in their mouth) ("**Prize Winner**"). Eligible Entrants will be required to show an empty mouth to a representative of the Promoter at the completion of the four (4) minutes.

A representative of the Promoter will determine which Eligible Entrant has eaten the highest quantity of hot dogs.

If an Eligible Entrant is disqualified, the Promoter is under no obligation to publish this fact. The Promoter undertakes to ensure transparency and to log the selection process appropriately in order for the results to be verified.

The Promoter may deem any Entry irregular and disqualify such Entry, in the following circumstances ("Invalid Entry"):

- a. an Entry from a person who is not an Eligible Entrant;
- b. an Entry that is fraudulent or forged; and
- c. an Entry that appears to have been tampered with.
- d. the Entry (or the entrant) otherwise does not comply with these Terms and Conditions.

Invalid Entries are not eligible to win a Prize. If a Prize Winner has an Invalid Entry, the Prize will be awarded to the Eligible Entrant who has consumed the second highest quantity of hot dogs. If a person with an Invalid Entry is awarded a Prize inadvertently, they must return it to the Promoter immediately upon request.

The Winner will be notified in person immediately at the conclusion of the Competition.

The Prize Winner must produce Valid ID that is acceptable to the Promoter or a representative of the Promoter in order to collect the Prize.

Your Entry is deemed to be received only when received by the Promoter. If your Entry is based on participation that is deemed invalid, your Entry into the Promotion will be deemed invalid.
