Tournament Schedule	On each Tournament Day (see table below) during the Tournament Period, Tournament sessions of approximately 5 minutes in length will run between 12:00pm and 7:30pm (AEDT) (each, a "Tournament Session"). The licensed person appointed by the Promoter with responsibility for overall control of the Tournament ("Tournament Manager") may alter the starting time of any Tournament Session if reasonable notice (at least 20 minutes) has been given to Eligible Entrants.

	"Invalid Entrant" means an entrant who is not an "Eligible Entrant" for the duration of the Tournament Period. Invalid Entrants are not, or will no longer be, eligible to enter or participate in the Tournament and will forfeit any entitlement to a Prize.					
Entry	Registration					
•	There is no entry fee.					
	To participate in the Tournament (an "Entry"), Eligible Entrants must present their membership card to the Tournament Manager and register with a signed Application Form (see below) at the tournament tables in					



the Tournament Location ("**Registration Desk**") on a Tournament Day between 12:00PM and 7:30PM during the Tournament Period. Eligible Entrants need only sign the Application Form once for the Tournament Period.

All Eligible Entrants in the Tournament may request to join a Tournament Session, subject to availability. Places in Tournament Sessions are allocated on a 'first in, first served' basis.

The Tournament Manager may require each Player to agree in writing with the Rules and these terms and conditions prior to entering into the Tournament.

The Promoter may refuse any application to register for the Tournament.

In the event of an Invalid Entry, the forfeited or returned Prize will instead be awarded to the Player with the next highest place and each subsequent Player on the leaderboard will be elevated by one place.

Withdrawal and non-attendance

Players can withdraw from the Tournament at any time and no financial penalty will be imposed.

If a registered Eligible Entrant fails to present themselves at the Tournament Location at the start of a Tournament Session for which they are registered or is absent during a Tournament Session, they will forfeit any entitlement to participate in the Tournament Session or win a Prize.

All entries are non-transferable.

Entry Limit

Eligible Entrants can only register for one (1) Tournament Session per Tournament Day and a total of five (5) Tournament Sessions per Tournament Week.

Conduct of the Tournament

Tournament structure

The minimum number of Eligible Entrants required to conduct a Tournament Session is one (1). The Star Sydney may cancel a Tournament Session if the minimum number of Eligible Entrants do not enter the Tournament Session.

The maximum number of Eligible Entrants who can participate in a Tournament Session is six (6), with a maximum of three (3) Eligible Entrants per active table and a minimum of one (1) active tables.

In each Tournament Session, an Eligible Entrant will start with \$1,000 in tournament chips ("**Tournament Chips**") on their assigned Tournament table. During a Tournament Session, Eligible Entrants may only play with their Tournament Chips on their assigned Tournament table.

The Star Sydney will assign places at Tournament tables on a 'first in, first served' basis prior to the commencement of the Tournament Session.

Each Eligible Entrant shall participate in a total of six (6) consecutive spins.

At the end of each Tournament Session, the Eligible Entrant's total Tournament Chip count for that Tournament Session will be calculated and recorded by a representative of the Promoter. The leaderboard will display the ten (10) Eligible Entrants with the highest total numbers of Tournament Chips from any Tournament Session for the Tournament Week, as recorded by the Promoter's representative.

At the end of each Tournament Session, any unused Tournament Chips must be returned to the Tournament Location. Tournament Chips for any Eligible Entrant will not be carried forward from Tournament Session to Tournament Session, nor aggregated across Tournament Sessions for the purposes the leaderboard.

The leaderboard will be reset to zero at the start of each Tournament Week.

Wagers

All wagers will be in units of the minimum permissible wagers set out above. A wager found to be less than the minimum will be required to be made up to the minimum if the Eligible Entrant holds sufficient Tournament Chips, or otherwise will be cancelled.

a. All wagers will be made only with Tournament Chips. Tournament Chips are chips issued to Eligible Entrants for the purposes of wagering and scoring in the Tournament. Tournament Chips have no cash value and are not redeemable for cash or any other type of chips or benefit.



- b. Eligible Entrants must wager at least the minimum for each round of play.
- c. Any Eligible Entrant who cannot wager at least the minimum prior to the commencement of a round will be eliminated and must vacate the table.
- d. A spin indicator may be used to indicate the spin number.
- e. Dealers will not accept any call bets from Eligible Entrants.

Time Restrictions

All Eligible Entrants participating in the Tournament will be limited to 60 seconds per spin to act. The 60 seconds shall commence when the dealer indicates it is the Eligible Entrant's turn to act. Where an Eligible Entrant does not place a wager within the allotted time, the Eligible Entrant's wager may be restricted to an amount equal to the stated minimum wager for the table.

After the allotted time (60 seconds) the dealer will spin the ball. Wagering will cease once the dealer spins the ball.

Pay-out Odds

Pay-out odds for each wager are as follows:

Chip Count

A Tournament Chip count will be conducted at the completion of each Tournament Session.

No Buy Backs

There is no opportunity for an eliminated Eligible Entrant to buy back into the Tournament after elimination.

No Pass Cards or Undisclosed Wagers

No pass cards or undisclosed wagers will be used in the Tournament.

Prize

The total Prize pool value for the Tournament is up to \$75,000.

The total Prize pool value for each Tournament Week and the Prizes available to be won for each Tournament Week are as follows:

To support the prevention of money laundering and terrorism financing activities, The Star Sydney will honour all monetary prizes by a crossed cheque made out to the winner, by electronic funds transfer to the winner or by a combination of these payment options (at the winner's election). The Star Sydney will not permit Prizes to be transferred, or redeemed or exchanged for cash.

Entertainment Credits refer to the choice of Casino Dollars or Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverage Vouchers. In the event where a Prize winner chooses Casino Dollars as their prize, they will forfeit 10% of their eligible Prize value.

Casino dollars will be credited to the winner's membership account within forty-eight (48) hours of the end of the Tournament Period. Casino Dollars are valid for one hundred and eighty (180) days from the member's last recorded rating. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverage Vouchers are valid for one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of issue. Vouchers will be credited to the winner's membership account within forty-eight (48) hours of the end of the Tournament Period. Vouchers can be redeemed on food and non-alcoholic beverages at selected outlets owned by the Promoter, subject to outlet opening hours and availability. Excludes special events and public holidays. Vouchers are not redeemable for cash and any unused portion after the expiry of the Voucher is non-refundable. Vouchers cannot be used to pay for alcoholic beverages. Vouchers can be used in conjunction with member benefits, discounts and other vouchers.

An Eligible Entrant may appear multiple times on the leaderboard and will be eligible for the corresponding Prize

Prize Determination

At the conclusion of the last Tournament Session of each Tournament Week:

- a. the ten (10) Eligible Entrants with the highest numbers of Tournament Chips on the Leaderboard for that Tournament Week will be Prize winners ("Prize Winners") and each Prize Winner will be awarded the Prize which corresponds to their Leaderboard Rank; and
- b. if two (2) or more Eligible Entrants jointly have the same number of Tournament Chips ("Joint Winners"), any Prize which corresponds to their Leaderboard rank will be divided (so far as practical) equally amongst the Joint Winners, so as not to exceed the total Prize pool available for that Tournament Week. In that event there will be more than ten (10) Prize Winners for that Tournament Week.

Prize Winners do not need to be present at the conclusion of the last Tournament Session of the relevant Tournament Week. Prizes will be made available at the Sovereign Concierge Desk at The Star Sydney ("Prize Claim Location") from the Monday following the end of the Tournament Week until 10:00pm (AEDT) on Sunday, 26 January 2025 ("Prize Claim Period"). To claim a Prize, a Prize Winner must visit the Prize Claim Location with their Card and Valid ID during the Prize Claim Period.

Valid ID means:

- a. a passport, Australian driver's licence or other form of photographic identification in which the photograph is clear and undamaged and that is acceptable to The Star Sydney; or
- b. two forms of non-photographic identification that are valid and acceptable to The Star Sydney.

Any Invalid Entrant will forfeit, and if applicable must return, any Prize. In the event of an invalid Entry, the forfeited or returned Prize will instead be awarded to the Contestant with the next highest (or equal highest if there were Joint Winners) number of Tournament Credits at the conclusion of the Tournament Week.

General Terms and Conditions

The Tournament is conducted by The Star Sydney in accordance with these General Terms and Conditions and the Rules of the Game for Roulette at The Star Sydney. A copy of the Rules of the Game can be found at

https://www.star.com.au/sydney/sites/star.com.au.sydney/files/roulette - rules of the game.pdf. These General Terms and Conditions incorporate and must be read together with the details outlined in the table above and with the Rules of the Game. By entering this Tournament, you accept these General Terms and Conditions. In the event of any inconsistency between these General Terms and Conditions and the Rules of the Game, the Rules of the Game prevail.

- 2 The **Star Club Terms and Conditions** also apply. **A copy can be found at** https://www.thestarclub.com.au/terms-conditions.
- If, at the time of a draw, a person is restricted or prevented from entering the casino area due to a 'temporary prevention of entry' for contravention of a Playbreak rule, that person is not eligible to claim a prize (even if they are the selected winner) and that person will forfeit any entitlement to a prize."
- 4 Your Entry must be received as described in the table above and is subject to the Entry limits and eligibility requirements stated in these Terms and Conditions. Your Entry is deemed to be received only when received by the Promoter. If your Entry is based on participation that is deemed invalid, or if your membership status is cancelled or otherwise amended so that you are no longer an Eligible Entrant, your Entry into the Tournament will be deemed invalid.

- Where relevant, it is your responsibility to open or close your rating by asking the Dealer/Games Supervisor to open or close your rating at any eligible table game, or to remove your card from the machine or game.
- The Promoter reserves the right to waive or vary the identification requirements specified in these Terms and Conditions in circumstances where the identity of the Prize winner is determinable without the assistance of the specified identification.
- 9 If you or your Entry are deemed by the Promoter to breach these Terms and Conditions, your Entry (or at the Promoter's discretion, all of your entries if you have multiple entries) will be voided.
- The Promoter may, at any time, require you to produce documentation to establish to the Promoter's satisfaction the validity of your Entries (including documentation establishing your identity, age, place of residence and place of employment). Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not waive those rights.
- 11 You must not:
 - a. tamper with the Tournament's Entry process;
 - b. engage in any conduct that may jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Tournament;
 - c. act in a disruptive, annoying, threatening, abusive or harassing manner directly or indirectly in relation to the Tournament;
 - d. do anything that may diminish the good name or reputation of the Promoter or any of its related entities or of the agencies or companies associated with this Tournament;



- e. breach any law; or
- f. behave in a way that is otherwise inappropriate or offensive directly or indirectly in relation to the Tournament.
- The Promoter is not liable for Entries, prize claims or correspondence that are, due to factors outside its reasonable control, misplaced, misdirected, delayed, lost, incomplete, illegible or incorrectly submitted.
- In the event of a dispute relating to these Terms and Conditions, the Promoter's decision is final. Where any person is not satisfied with a decision of the Promoter relating to this Tournament, the person may lodge a complaint with an inspector under section 33 of the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007* (NSW).
- The Promoter may cancel or change any Prize offered under the Tournament if there are any changes to the law which would or might render the Tournament or any Prize offered under the Tournament unlawful.
- The Prize values are correct as at the date of preparing these Terms and Conditions and include any applicable GST. The Promoter is not responsible for any change in Prize value. You agree that if a Prize (or element of a Prize) is unavailable for any reason the Promoter may provide another item of equal or higher value, subject to any necessary approval by any regulatory authority.
- If the Promoter determines that the integrity of the Tournament has been compromised it may, subject to notifying the relevant regulatory authority, either postpone the Tournament or any Tournament Session until such a time as the integrity of the Tournament has been validated or cancel the Tournament or any compromised Tournament Session.
- To the extent that a situation, malfunction, or other issue arises for which these Terms and Conditions make no provision or in relation to which the relevant terms and conditions are unclear, the Promoter reserves the right to:
 - a. make a decision regarding those circumstances which is not inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions; and/or
 - b. postpone the Tournament or any Tournament Session to a time and place which will allow the Tournament or the Tournament Session to be conducted in accordance with all Terms and Conditions other than those Terms and Conditions which specify the time and place of the Tournament or Tournament Session.
- If this Tournament cannot run as planned for any reason beyond the Promoter's control, including but not limited to: act of god, law, public health order, pandemic, software, hardware or communications issues, unauthorised intervention, tampering, fraud or technical failure, the Promoter may end, change, suspend or cancel the Tournament or disqualify affected entries/entrants, subject to any necessary approval by a regulatory authority.
- The Promoter may in any event cancel the Tournament without liability. In that case the Promoter will refund any applicable entry fees.
- The Promoter may disclose your personal information, including details of Prize winners where required or authorised to do so by or under law or the disclosure is reasonably necessary to enforce the law. This may occur under the laws that apply to the Promoter's business, for example, where a regulatory authority requests information from the Promoter.
- The Promoter is not responsible for any tax implications arising from you winning a prize. You should seek independent financial advice. If for GST purposes this Tournament results in any supply being made for non-monetary consideration, you must follow the Australian Taxation Office's stated view that where the parties are at arm's length, goods and services exchanged are of equal GST inclusive market values.
- 22 Should a Prize winner consent to having his/her photograph taken, that Prize winner consents to having his/her name and photograph published in any form of media and agrees to participate in any reasonable promotion requested by the Promoter.



- 23 Each Prize winner's name and/or their membership number will be published on The Star App within 48 hours of the conclusion of the Tournament.

- In these Terms and Conditions, the word "including" and any similar words are not words of limitation.
- Nothing in these Terms and Conditions restricts, excludes or modifies any consumer rights under any statute including the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth).
- Subject to the previous paragraph, the Promoter and the agencies and companies associated with this Tournament are not liable (including in negligence) for any loss (including indirect, special or consequential loss or loss of profits), expense, damage, personal injury, illness or death suffered in connection with this Tournament or any Prize (including the use of any Prize), except for any liability which under statute cannot be excluded (in which case that liability is limited to the greatest extent allowed by law).
- Without limiting paragraph 27, the Promoter and the agencies and companies associated with this Tournament are not liable for:
 - a. any loss of, damage to or delay in delivery of Prizes; or
 - b. any damage that occurs to Prizes if/when displayed at the Promoter's premises,

to the extent those things are due to factors outside the Promoter's reasonable control.

- The Promoter needs to collect the personal information of each entrant so that the entrant can be entered into the Tournament. The Promoter will use entrants' personal information to conduct and manage the Tournament.
