Notification of Draw Winner/s

The name and membership number of each Drawn Entrant will be announced on the public address system and displayed at screens at the Main Draw Location.

The Promoter does not guarantee that all Prize Draw announcements will be audible and understandable in all parts of the Main Draw Location at all times.

Redraw/s

- The Promoter will not permit a Prize, Entry or other feature of the Promotion to be transferred, or exchanged or redeemed for cash.
