Promotional Period	This Promotion commences at 7:00pm AEDT on Wednesday, 12 June 2024 and concludes at 9:00pm AEST on Wednesday, 31 July, 2024.
Eligible Entrants	<p>Participation in the Promotion is limited to persons who are, for the duration of the Promotional Period:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. aged 18 years or over; b. residents of New South Wales; c. not excluded (including an exclusion direction or self-exclusion order) from a casino or premises operated by The Star Entertainment Group Limited or its related entities; d. not the subject of a Withdrawal of License from The Star Sydney, The Star Gold Coast or Treasury Brisbane; e. not an Invalid Entrant; f. not a director, officer, manager, employee or contractor of The Star Entertainment Group Limited or any of its related entities (including, the Promoter); g. not an immediate family member (including a sibling, parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, spouse, former spouse, de facto or former de facto partner, including a step-relation and an adoptive relation) of any person listed in item (f) above or of their spouse, former spouse, de facto partner or former de facto partner; and <p>(“Eligible Entrants”).</p> <p>“Invalid Entrant” means an entrant who is not an “Eligible Entrant” for the duration of the Promotional Period. Invalid Entrants are not, or will no longer be, eligible to enter or participate in the Promotion and will forfeit any entitlement to a prize.</p> <p>The promoter reserves the right , at its sole and absolute discretion, to deem any irregular entries, including entries that have not been completed properly as “Invalid Entries”.</p> <p>Invalid Entries cannot win prizes.</p>
Entry	During the Promotional Period, an Eligible Entrant may take part in a trivia competition held at the following times:

- a. Competition one (1): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 12 June 2024
- b. Competition two (2): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024
- c. Competition three (3): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 3 July 2024
- d. Competition four (4): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 10 July 2024
- e. Competition five (5): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 24 July 2024
- f. Competition six (6): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 24 July 2024
- g. Competition seven (7): from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Wednesday 31 July 2024

(each a “**Competition**”)

To enter the Promotion an Eligible Entrant must enter a Competition. To enter a Competition, Eligible Entrants must:

- a) attend Sports Bar at the commencement of a Competition (the Promoter recommends arriving at least 10 minutes prior to the commencement of a Competition);
- b) form a team consisting between two (2) to eight (8) Eligible Entrants;
- c) register their team name and number of team members with the trivia host prior to the commencement of a Competition in order to receive an answer sheet;
- d) work with their team to answer a series of trivia questions on various topics provided by the trivia host within the time allowed by the trivia host (approximately 60 seconds). Each team must write their answers on the answer sheet provided to them during team registration. Teams will earn points for correct answers to trivia questions, but not for any mini-game questions;
- e) submit their team’s answer sheet to the trivia host at the end of the Competition as directed by the trivia Host. Answer sheets will not be accepted by 3 minutes after Trivia Host requests all answer sheets be returned to them;
- f) the team with the most points at the end of the Competition will win the Prize

During each competition, the trivia host may conduct a mini-game whereby teams are given a series of true and false style questions to answer. Teams will be eliminated from the mini-game when they answer a question incorrectly. The last standing team will be awarded a mini-prize valued no more than RRP\$20. All monetary prizes will be paid in the form of cheque or EFTPOS. For the avoidance of doubt, teams will not accumulate any Competition points during the mini-game and the mini-prize will not be exchangeable for cash. Further, the mini-prize is given to the team to be shared, and not on an individual basis.

An Eligible Entrant may only enter themselves and their team once per Competition. The Promoter takes no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries. Incomplete, illegible or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid.

The team with the second most points accumulated from correct answers to trivia questions (excluding all mini-game questions) will win a prize of \$200 (Prize).</p> <p>All monetary prizes will be paid in the form of cheque or EFTPOS. <p>Judging</p>	<p>The panel of Judges will consist of one (1) trivia host and one (1) venue manager of Sports Bar. The winning teams of each Competition (Prize Winner/s) will be the team with the highest score, second highest score and third highest score as determined by the Judges in their absolute discretion. The Judge’s decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered. The Judges will select two (2) Prize Winner/s at approximately 9:00pm on the following dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Wednesday 12 June 2024 b) Wednesday 19 June 2024 c) Wednesday 3 July 2024 d) Wednesday 10 July 2024 e) Wednesday 24 July 2024 f) Wednesday 31 July 2024 <p>Prize Winners will be announced live in the venue by 9:15pm on the day of judging.</p> <p>If, despite its reasonable efforts, the Promoter cannot locate the Prize Winner or confirm a Prize Winner by 9:15pm on the respective night of the Judging from the Prize Winner, the Prize Winner forfeits the Prize and is no longer the Prize Winner for the purposes of these terms and conditions.</p> <p>If the Prize Winner forfeits the Prize pursuant to clause 17, the Judges will select the next highest scoring team of the Competition as the Prize Winner (“Second Judging”). If required, the Second Judging will take place at the venue by 9:00pm the same day. The Promoter will take reasonable efforts to notify the Prize Winner as a result of the Second Judging in venue immediately after the Second Judging.
